Workplace investigations present a plethora of ethical challenges for lawyers overseeing or conducting them. These challenges become all the more pronounced when a C-suite executive is accused of harassment. The in-house counsel's job is to represent the company, but sometimes the question of who the client is can get a bit muddled. This session will focus on attorney-client privilege and related concerns that may arise when conducting harassment investigations, including investigations at the C-suite level. The speakers will discuss various principles under the Rules of Professional Conduct, including conflicts of interest (Rule 1.7), truthfulness obligations (Rule 4.1), dealing with witnesses who may or may not be represented by counsel (Rule 4.2), and the lawyer as a witness (Rule 3.7).
