DESCRIPTION

To say that the healthcare industry faces unique issues during the pandemic would be an understatement. Those issues are coupled with privacy concerns and obligations—some preexisting, some arising from state emergency standards, and some imposed by occupational safety and health standards such as the California Division of Occupational Safety and Health's (Cal/OSHA) Aerosol Transmissible Diseases Standard, which covers healthcare providers and excepts them from the agency's emergency temporary standards.
