Pay transparency is becoming a significant and challenging compliance issue for employers that have prioritized pay equity. The U.S. Congress currently is considering transparency legislation, and a number of states and local jurisdictions have already passed laws designed to make it easier for applicants and employees to learn their peers' compensation.
