

Nevada adopted heat illness prevention regulations on November 15, 2024, with enforcement beginning on April 29, 2025.

Employers in Nevada with 10 or more employees are required to establish a written heat illness prevention plan. This plan must include, among other elements, a designated person responsible for the plan, an assessment of heat illness risks, access to water, scheduled rest breaks, training programs, mitigation measures for heat illness risks, and emergency procedures.

To assist employers in complying with these new regulations, we have created a Nevada Heat Illness Prevention Plan Template Package.
