

Senate Bill Introduced to Authorize Same-Sex Marriage in New Jersey

A bill introduced in the Senate on June 9 (S1967) and Assembly on June 16 (A2978), the “Freedom of Religion and Equality in Civil Marriage Act,” would authorize same-sex marriage in New Jersey and simultaneously would allow clergy to refuse to solemnize same-sex marriages. The bill would render partners to a civil union to be deemed “married” and their civil union licenses and certificates would be deemed to be marriage licenses and certificates.

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
